Booking

When booking the site we ask that you specify what you are going to use the space for, we would also ask that you include the name of your business or group (if applicable) along with a brief outline of what you want to use the space for (i.e. AB Company, Annual General Meeting of Shareholders or XYoga, Yoga Class for Beginners).

An enquiry does not mean that your booking is accepted or confirmed. Confirmation will be sent through E-Mail or Text (whichever you have chosen as your preferred method) and will be under the condition that Terms and Conditions have been read and agreed to.

What is included in your hire?

The Chapel has a fitted kitchen which includes: 3 sinks (one for hand washing, other for food and the final for dish washing); a kettle; an oven which has a grill and stove top with extractor fan; an under-counter fridge (no freezer included); mugs, bowls, side plates and dinner plates along with cutlery for up to 60 people; two bins for rubbish (rubbish should be removed by yourself at the end of hire and disposed of). There are two WC, each have been fitted with an Accessible toilet including hand rails and appropriate sinks; these also have a bin each for any sanitary rubbish that is generated over the course of your hire; soap and disposable hand towels are provided and will be in the storage room; the largest WC has an emergency pull cord alarm which can be used to alert others when assistance may be needed in the bathroom. There is a long wooden trestle table in the main hall which can be used as well as three pews (one is fitted) and another smaller table which has wheels. 60 wooden folding chairs with soft taupe coloured pads and 10 wooden trestle tables. White table cloths and white chair pads can be hired by arrangement at additional cost.

(Baby changing table is due to be installed 12 Nov. 2025.)

The site

With over 150 years of history on this site we have done our best to perform a sympathetic restoration using as many materials and features that were originally part of the chapel as possible including pews and the original organ which can still be played.

Deslisles Chapel is a stand alone property with a gravel exterior which can comfortably hold around 15 vehicles. The front of the building has three steps which lead to a large set of double doors and inside is a porch with two additional exterior side doors which can also be accessed from outside via three steps; these doors need to be opened from inside.

When in the porch there are two internal doors, the one on the left is a door which leads directly into the main hall and to the right is a corridor which leads to the hall and provides access to the larger Accessible WC and a small store room.

After going through the corridor from the porch there is a staircase to the left which leads to the mezzanine which is around 4 x 11 metres. In the hall below there is an area that is around 4 x 7.25 metres. The light switches can be found under here next to the door which leads to the porch.

The approximate size of the rest of the hall is 12.25 x 11 metres from the end of the mezzanine. The hall floor is solid oak. The hall also features the original choir pews and organ from the chapel which still works and is serviced at least once a year. Either side of the choir stalls and organ is a door which leads to the back. On the left is the door which leads to the kitchen which is down a small set of stairs. When you reach the bottom of the stairs you can turn right into another store room which has a door on the other side. This leads to the stairwell corridor. When you turn right there is a small staircase which leads back to the hall or you can turn left to the smaller WC or back rear door which acts as a fire exit.
